

NATIONAL PHARMACY WEEK-2025

Theme: “Pharmacists as Advocates of Vaccination”

EVENT: QUIZ **(RULES AND REGULATIONS)**

1. All M. Pharm, B. Pharm & D. Pharm. students can participate in this event.
2. Only team entries are eligible, and team shall consist of two students.
3. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments.
4. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, true/false statement, specific answer question, etc.
5. Audience/supporters shall not give any hints or clues to the competitors.
6. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after shortlisting.

PRELIMINARY ROUND

Each team would be given a set of question paper containing 25 multiple choice objective type questions.

- Time limit – 15 minutes.
- In case of tie between 2 or more students/teams, further 5 questions would be asked for final selection.
- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round.

FINALS

Round 1: GENERAL ROUND (General Knowledge and Current Affairs): 3 questions/team.

In this round, a team gets 30 seconds to answer the question intended for it, and is awarded 10 points for answering it correctly.

If a team cannot answer a question, they can pass it or after 30 seconds it gets automatically passed to the next team.

The team members can discuss before giving the answer.

There is no negative marking for wrong answers.

Round 2: PHARMACY: 5 questions/team.

In this round, each team will be asked questions one after another.

On immediate completion of a question, each team gets 30 seconds to answer it.

Questions will not be passed to the next team, if unanswered

10 points is awarded for the correct answer.

No negative points for the wrong answers.

Round 3: AUDIO-VISUAL: 2 questions/team.

Each team will be shown a picture or made to listen to an audio clip.

The team will have 30 seconds to answer it.

The team members can discuss before giving the answer.

Questions will be passed to the next team, if unanswered.

10 points is awarded for the correct answer.

No negative points for wrong answers.

Round 4: CAMPUS-RELATED: 8 questions

A total of 8 questions will be fired at all the teams one after another. The teams will have to press the buzzer to answer the question first.

The team that presses the buzzer first, gets the chance to answer it first.

The question has to be answered in 10 seconds.

10 points for the correct answer.

If two teams press the buzzer together. The decision of the quiz-master will be final.

Round 5: RAPID FIRE: 12 questions

A total of 12 questions will be fired at all the teams one after another. The teams will have to press the buzzer to answer the question first.

The team that presses the buzzer first, gets the chance to answer it first.

The question has to be answered in 5 seconds.

10 points for the correct answer.

If two teams press the buzzer together.

The decision of the quiz-master will be final.
