

Japan's Eisai developing dementia drug for US market

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Tokyo: Japanese drugmaker Eisai is developing a dementia treatment that it aims to commercialise in the U.S. by fiscal 2030, the Nikkei reported on Sunday.

The new drug targets a protein called tau, which causes symptoms of Alzheimer's disease, the Nikkei newspaper reported.
